

Utsubuki Mountain

Utsubukiyama, the symbol of Kurayoshi, is 204m above sea level. Utsubuki Castle was built by Yamana Moriyoshi in the Middle Ages. It is also popular as a trekking course with well-developed walking paths. It is a treasure trove of natural forests covered virgin forest, and you can enjoy forest bathing throughout the year



Utsubuki Park

It is known as the best cherry blossom vie spot in the Sanin area, and azaleas and camellias also grow in clumps. The park also has a corner for small animals such as monkeys and goats, making it a relaxing place park in Japan after Tokyo Hibiya Park.



Kuravoshi Museum

A museum built with the motif of a group of white-walled storehouses. Exhibits include archaeological materials, works of art related to the local area, and folklore materials.
